My Sabbatical Practice Regimen – Week 1

Objectives

- 1. To develop the discipline of prolonged, self-study to maximize the results to my playing & teaching and prepare me for future sabbaticals.
- 2. To expose me to as many of the teaching materials I have, so that I can be aware of these resources for future practices & sabbaticals, and to glean ideas from these for my teaching. I won't be super proficient at any one thing, but will have exposure to as many resources as I can. This time around I'll be relying on spill-over for a combined effect. This will also help keep the prolonged study interesting.
- 3. To raise my playing & teaching confidence levels, so as to expand my success potential in both. This is the most economical way to get the most intensive study in. In the future, I may be able to afford outside workshops and/or summer programs at Schools of Music, but I need to have my level of commitment & discipline at a higher level for that
- 4. I can expand on this Curriculum approach for my own study and may be able to capitalize on this by offering such guided studies with my better students.
- 5. It will help me organize my materials for designing my own drum books. By making copies of the material as I study and making my notes directly on these, I'm half-way to creating my own books. These notes will help immediately in my teaching of the material.

Schedule

- 1. Set time to help create the habit and eliminate distractions: 4 hrs: 8-12pm, lunch @ 12-1pm, 4 hrs 1-5pm, dinner @ 5-6pm, then 2 hrs 6-8pm.
- 2. Answering machine will make it clear that I am not available until after 8pm. I will keep the phone & cellular turned off and computer I want no distractions during my study period.
- 3. I can see my friends at lunch or dinner or after 8pm.
- 4. After 8pm, I can answer e-mail, phone calls, deal with future scheduling, and get out to see AS MUCH MUSIC WITH MY FRIENDS AS I CAN, and also jamm with Tom, Mike, Daniel, or whoever.

Strategy

- 1. Break the study into 1/2 hour blocks to prevent over-stressing the limbs & to keep the mind sharp.
- 2. During the switch, drink water to prevent dehydration and accompanying fatigue. Also, stretch & exercise the back, legs, and arms to keep the blood flowing & prevent injury, numbing, and fatigue.
- 3. Rotate through the Curriculum below so that none of the limbs are being fatigued: work on hands, then feet, then combinations.
